
# The BUP's annual Student Conference 2022

## Average expectation was 7.74



Average answer was 8.21



Average answer was 9.47



Average answer was 9.62



Average answer was 9.40



Average answer was 8.96



Average answer was 9.45



Average answer was 8.66










# How did you find the field trip to Lilla Bjers organic farm?

Average answer was 9.17








## How did you find the guided tour of Visby?

## Average expectation was 7.45



Average expectation was 8.83



Average expectation was 8.12



Average expectation was 8.47



## Average expectation was 9.45


## Compared to previous years:
