#### **PROGRAMME**

This 4-day boot camp at Igor Sikorsky Kyiv Polytechnic Institute has been organized for students and young researchers at Ukrainian universities who want to participate in international research and innovation projects. Participants will enhance their career prospects with intensive training in international cooperation, team-building, inclusion, and other practices that will make them valuable research and innovation team members. In the first 3 mornings, participants will attend plenary sessions providing them with an overview of the EU research and innovation system, its policies and funding mechanisms, and its connection with the EU education system and academic mobility. In the afternoons, participants will form teams and, under the guidance of experts, attend workshops providing them with hands-on learning experiences in project initiation and the writing of competitive project proposals. On the 4th day, they will make public presentations of their projects, with evaluation by an international jury. Members of the winning team will receive an invitation to participate in the student conference "Challenges of Sustainable Development in the Baltic Sea Region because of the war in Ukraine", which will be held in April-May 2024 in Poznan (Poland). Finally, each participant will receive a certificate of attendance and share impressions of the boot camp.
